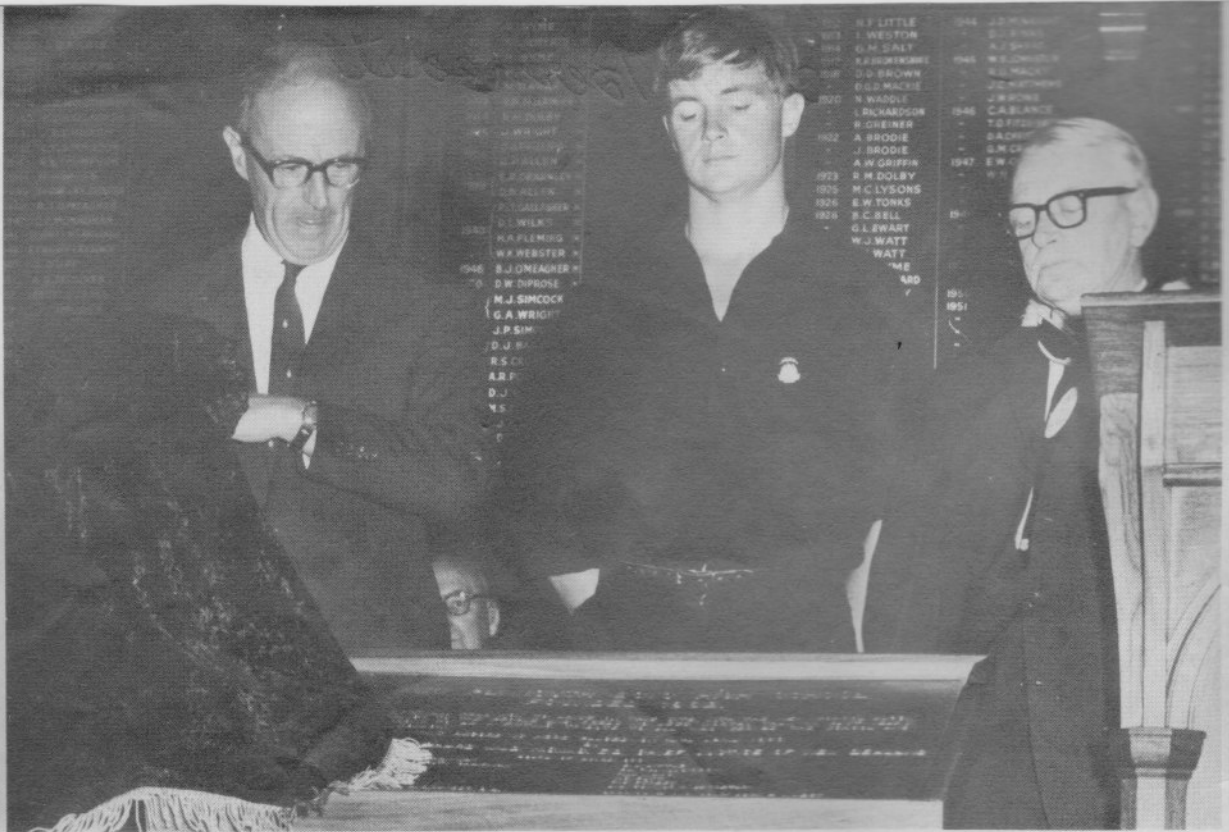

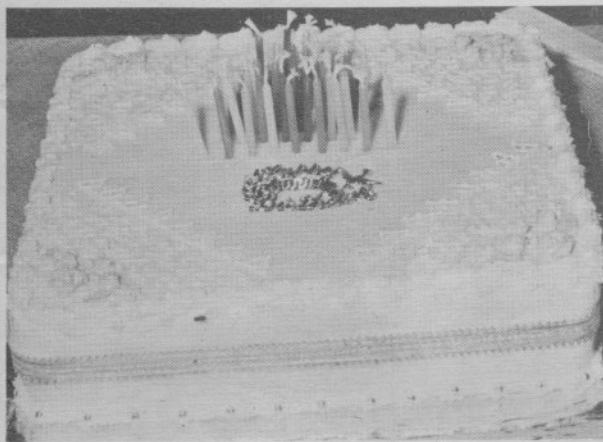




Easter Celebrations
